## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

With the implementation of the new curriculum in British Columbia for K-9, and the drafts set to be piloted at the secondary level in the coming academic year, there is a focus on the use of technology, on access to digital tools and a great importance for students to develop the skills to be able to determine what they read and view as being valid. This is especially significant in the current climate of "fake news" and "alternate facts" where one is able to easily produce something plausible. However, there has been much attention to the production of the written text as a means to develop students' critical skills when reading print. And while new curricular documents tout the importance of developing visual analytical skills among students of all ages, there still appears to be a lack of resources, and time provided for

teachers to learn how to use these tools and consider how they might implement these tools in their classrooms. This course will introduce such resources and tools to teachers.
