PROGRAM OVERVIEW

In the context of BC's redesigned curriculum, teachers are expected to engage 21st Century learners. As a result, teachers are looking for ways to effectively incorporate digital technologies to develop meaningful learning experiences using current, and often free, digital technologies.

This 2-day hands-on workshop addresses the teachers' need to **develop knowledge, understanding, and proficiency** to successfully integrate educational technologies into their teaching and learning context. These workshops will focus on the why and how of **using tools for multimedia creation, digital story telling, collaboration, student engagement and formative assessment**. The examples and tools are designed primarily for K-9 teachers, but alternatives will be provided for other grades.
