A unique French language immersion program situated in the historic setting of les plaines d'Abraham in the heart of Quebec City!

Join the UBC Faculty of Education for a 19-day non-credit language and culture immersion program at the Collège Mérici in Quebec City. This program is designed to meet the needs of all French second language teachers – both experienced and those entering the profession – and is open to all levels of French speakers, from beginner to advanced.

- Develop your oral communication skills and an appreciation of Quebec's unique culture during morning classes, afternoon workshops and field trips.
- Course content is focused on improving teacher-participants' ability to converse in French by building on their classroom experiences and teaching interests.
- Our instructors are experienced language educators who interact with participants both inside and outside the classroom, making this a truly immersive language experience.
- The program is offered during the Quebec City Summer Festival; experience everything from street musicians, concerts and plays to parades and fireworks on the St. Lawrence River.

NOTE: The program is delivered entirely in French. It is recommended that teacher-participants arrive with a basic understanding of the language.

LOCATION

The Collège Mérici is located in Quebec City, near the Plains of Abraham, within easy walking distance of all attractions. Participants are responsible for arranging their own transportation to Quebec. Once in Quebec City, the best way to get around is on foot. Buses, taxis and other mobility service providers are easily available.

ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

The cost of the program includes single occupancy accommodation at Collège Mérici for 18 nights (July 1-18). Participants have their own rooms in four-bedroom apartments, and share kitchen and bathroom facilities. Each apartment has a fully equipped kitchen, a living room and dining area. Lunches are provided on weekdays, while breakfasts and dinners are the participant's responsibility. Spouses and children cannot be accommodated during the program.

PROGRAM FEES & BURSARIES

The total cost of the program is \$3,400 which includes a non-refundable \$300 registration fee. Every year the government offers the Canadian Heritage bursary to BC teachers taking part in this program if they speak French as an additional language and/or will be involved in the teaching or supervision of French programs. This year BC teachers will be eligible for a \$1800 bursary.



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
